

## MEDICAL COUNTERMEASURE (MCM) POINT OF DISPENSING (POD) LOGISTICS MANAGER

<b>RESOURCE CATEGORY</b>	Medical and Public Health
<b>RESOURCE KIND</b>	Personnel
<b>OVERALL FUNCTION</b>	The Medical Countermeasure (MCM) Point of Dispensing (POD) Logistics Manager oversees logistics operations at MCM POD sites
<b>COMPOSITION AND ORDERING SPECIFICATIONS</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. This position can be ordered as a single resource or in conjunction with a National Incident Management System (NIMS) typed of Dispensing Management Team)</li> <li>2. Discuss logistics for deploying this position, such as working conditions, length of deployment, security, lodging, transportation, and meals, prior to deployment</li> <li>3. The position typically works 12 hours per shift, is self-sustainable for 72 hours, and is deployable up to 14 days</li> </ol>

Each type of resource builds on the qualifications of the type below it. For example, Type 1 qualifications include the qualifications in Type 2, plus an increase in capability. Type 1 is the highest qualification level.

Coordinates with the incident Logistics Section for service, sanitation, and supply needs for the MCM POD</li> <li>5. Coordinates with the MCM POD Medical Oversight Manager to ensure proper handling and disposal of any biohazard/biowaste materials</li> <li>6. Conducts briefings and provides just-in-time-training</li> </ol>	Not Specified

A background check completed within the past 12 months</li> <li>2. A sex-offender registry check</li> <li>3. A local, state, and national driving and criminal history</li> </ol>
