OVERALL FUNCTION	The Special Weapons and Tactics (SWAT) Team Leader develops and executes SWAT operational tactics and training
COMPOSITION AND ORDERING SPECIFICATIONS	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. This position can be ordered as a single resource or in conjunction with a NIMS typed team (SWAT Team). 2. Discuss logistics for deploying this position, such as security, communications, lodging, transportation, and meals, prior to deployment 3. This position typically works 8 hours per shift, is self-sustainable for 72 hours, and is deployable for up to three days SWAT Team

Each type of resource builds on the qualifications of the type below it. For example, Type 1 qualifications include the qualifications in Type 2, plus an increase in capability. Type 1 is the highest qualification level.

IS-700: National Incident Management System, An Introduction 5. IS-800: National Response Framework, An Introduction 6. Department-approved basic and advanced SWAT training 7.
