

MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR TEAM - LIGHT EQUIPMENT PUBLIC WORKS

DESCRIPTION	This team performs preventative maintenance and repair on response vehicles and equipment.
RESOURCE CATEGORY	Public Works
RESOURCE KIND	Team with personnel/equipment components
OVERALL FUNCTION	This team is experienced in light repairs, lubrication, and other preventive maintenance of vehicles and light equipment. This includes police vehicles, pick-up trucks and ambulances.
COMPOSITION AND ORDERING SPECIFICATIONS	Identify supporting resources based on mission requirements. Ordering Specifications: Security requirements should be determined by the requesting agency based upon actual field conditions and intelligence, and provided to the responding team.

Each type of resource builds on the qualifications of the type below it. For example, Type 1 qualifications include the qualifications in Type 2, plus an increase in capability. Type 1 is the highest qualification level.

GENERAL EQUIPMENT PER TEAM	1 Field service truck Necessary tools and equipment based on ordering specifications	Examples of tools and equipment include vehicle diagnostic equipment, wrenches, screwdrivers.
COMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT PER TEAM	Cell phones Portable radios Satellite phone	Not Specified
LOGISTICS SUPPLIES PER TEAM	Water and other potable fluids Food Shelter Sanitation	Not Specified
