

**CREW TRANSPORT (FIREFIGHTING CREW) (NEW)**

<b>DESCRIPTION</b>	The Crew Transport (Firefighting Crew) is a vehicle that transports firefighting crews
<b>RESOURCE CATEGORY</b>	Fire/Hazardous Materials
<b>RESOURCE KIND</b>	Equipment
<b>OVERALL FUNCTION</b>	The Crew Transport (Firefighting Crew) transports a specified number of personnel
<b>COMPOSITION AND ORDERING SPECIFICATIONS</b>	1. Discuss logistics for this equipment, such as security, transportation, maintenance, and fuel, prior to deployment 2. Provider ensures separate storage space and restraint mechanisms for equipment in addition to passenger space

Each type of resource builds on the qualifications of the type below it. For example, Type 1 qualifications include the qualifications in Type 2, plus an increase in capability. Type 1 is the highest qualification level.
