

SHELTER MANAGEMENT TEAM

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| DESCRIPTION | The Shelter Management Team coordinates and manages resources in a congregate care facility, to provide a safe, accessible, and secure shelter environment for disaster survivors. |
| RESOURCE CATEGORY | Mass Care Services |
| RESOURCE KIND | Team |
| OVERALL FUNCTION | The Shelter Management Team serves as a core management team for shelter operations, including resident and facility support services |
| COMPOSITION AND ORDERING SPECIFICATIONS | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Discuss logistics for deploying this team, such as security, lodging, transportation, and meals, prior to deployment 2. The team works up to 12 hours per shift, is self-sustainable for 72 hours, and is deployable for up to 14 days 3. Order a National Incident Management System (NIMS) Type 1 Shelter Management Team for all Long-Term Shelters 4. Order a NIMS Type 1 Shelter Management Team for all NIMS Type 1 Short-Term Shelters 5. Order a NIMS Type 2 Shelter Manager Team for all NIMS Type 2, 3, or 4 Short-Term Shelters 6. Public health, behavioral, medical, support for household pets, service and assistance animals, security, and child care are not part of the Shelter Management Team and requestor should order these positions separately 7. The Shelter Management Team does not include shelter staff; refer to the National Mass Care Strategy (NMCS) Sheltering Guidance Aid and Staffing Matrix for sample staffing ratios |

Each type of resource builds on the qualifications of the type below it. For example, Type 1 qualifications include the qualifications in Type 2, plus an increase in capability. Type 1 is the highest qualification level.
