Compiles, analyzes, and disseminates mass evacuee-related information used to facilitate the rapid, efficient, and safe evacuation of threatened populations, including unaccompanied minors, people with disabilities and those with access and functional needs, household pets, and service and assistance animals 3. Coordinates with other agencies, groups, or entities that support the evacuation effort, to include non-governmental organizations and the private sector 4. Assists in identifying and filling staffing, material, and equipment gaps at mass evacuee support sites 5. Tracks and reports on mass evacuee support activities at mass evacuee sites | COMPOSITION AND ORDERING SPECIFICATIONS | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Discuss logistics for this team, such as security, lodging, transportation, and meals, prior to deployment 2. The team typically works 12 hours per shift, is self-sustainable for 72 hours, and is deployable for up to 14 days 3. Order evacuation teams, such as an Incident Management Team, separately |
